Jocelyn is a museum and heritage professional with a commitment to learning and development. She has experience of encouraging engagement with a wide range of audiences, including schools, families and older learners. She has a special interest in supporting organisations run by volunteers.

Jocelyn began work in museums in 1991, seconded by a community development charity to a reminiscence project in Oxfordshire. She then spent 3 years as Oral History Officer, before moving to Reading Museum Service to focus on museum education. At Reading she was part of a small team working on the redevelopment of the Museum and took the lead in evaluation, adult learning and training.

Jocelyn's connection with the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) began in 2000, when she managed one of the first HLF-funded access projects. Running a 2.5 year partnership project with 12 museums gave her the skills she needed to become an Access and Learning Adviser for MLA South East in 2002.

In 2007, Jocelyn became an independent consultant and joined Cultural Consulting Network. She is a mentor for the Museums Association's AMA and is on the Register of Support Services for HLF, mentoring community and heritage groups working on oral history projects and developing Activity Plans in connection with their fund-raising applications.
